

CALL for GRANTS from IUSS for World Congress of Soil Science 2022



The IUSS Executive Committee is pleased to announce that early-career scientists who submitted a scientific abstract, as presenting author, for WCSS-2022 to be held on 31 July to 5 August 2022 in Glasgow, Scotland, will be eligible for a travel grant.

Support is limited to 20,000 USD in total; 10,000 USD for women and 10,000 USD for men with a maximum support of 1,000 USD per applicant participating in person. Support will only be paid as a reimbursement of travel costs and/or registration fee to the WCSS-2022 incurred.

Selection criteria

Support is only for early-career scientists who are high-quality Master or PhD students or who have completed a Master or PhD degree less than 3 years ago.

Applicants need to send their applications to <u>iuss@umweltbundesamt.at</u> by March 15, 2022, accompanied by the following documentation written in English:

- a) Application letter including the level of funding being requested up to a max. of 1,000 USD (PDF file).
- b) Student certificate or copy of Master or PhD certificate.
- c) Confirmation of abstract approval.
- d) Two page CV (PDF file).
- e) Confirmation letter from a national soil science society (Full member of IUSS meaning the agreed subscription fee must be paid) confirming your membership of that society.

Grants evaluation committee

The selection of those applicants to be supported by these grants will be carried out by an IUSS Committee consisting of selected members of the IUSS Executive Committee.

Results

Applicants who are selected to obtain the requested financial support will be notified directly by the IUSS no later than May 1st, 2022.
